Barrett Summer Scholars

is a week-long residential 2024 summer enrichment program designed for academically talented and motivated students entering grades 9th-12th beginning in Fall 2024. Participants engage in an honors course and an elective taught by university faculty to prepare them for enrollment and success at ASU and Barrett, the Honors College.

Eligibility

Open to students entering grades 9th-12th in Fall 2024. Academically motivated and/ or high-achieving students are encouraged to apply. While there is no minimum GPA required, eligible students should demonstrate a cumulative GPA of 2.7 or higher (except for students entering 9th grade in Fall 2024).

10th grade Downtown Campus (Phoenix) June 9-June 13, 2024

11th grade West Valley Campus (Glendale) July 7–July 11, 2024

\$1,000 per participant, including a \$50 non-refundable registration fee. Payment is required upon program acceptance. Need-based scholarships are offered.
