Admission steps for veterans

Be inspired to live your best life

When choosing where to go to college, you're wise to look for a school that offers you the opportunity for a lifetime of success. At Arizona State University, you'll join a vibrant community that will help you explore your interests and become a lifelong learner. Through quality academics, enrichment opportunities, and support from friends and faculty, you'll graduate prepared to take on the world in all the ways you've dreamed of.

Admission requirements:

First-year students

11 or fewer transferable semester credits completed after high school.

Meet one of the following:

- 3.00 core GPA.
- Admissible SAT or ACT score.
- Top 25% class rank.

Meet our 16 core competencies.

Transfer students

24 or more transferable semester credits completed after high school.

Meet one of the following:

- 2.50 GPA with 12 or more transferable college credits (Students with 12–23 credits must meet first-year and transfer criteria).
- 2.50 GPA and associate degree (nonresident).
- 2.00 GPA and associate degree (resident).

Graduate students

Admission criteria is program-specific.

Must have earned a bachelor's degree or higher from a regionally accredited institution in the U.S. or the equivalent of a U.S. bachelor's degree from an international institution that is officially recognized by that country.

Don't forget your CCAF or JST.

Community College of the Air Force Transcripts: Sent to ASU officially during the application process. Will be used to calculate GPA, transfer courses and as part of the admission decision.

Joint Service Transcripts: Sent officially to ASU during the application process. Will not be used when making the admission decision but will be evaluated for potential transfer credits.

Steps to ASU enrollment

Prior to admission

1. Apply for VA benefits.

It takes approximately one to two months for benefits to be approved. Start the process early to ensure a smooth transition to the university.

2. Apply to ASU.

Complete the online application, pay the application fee and submit your transcripts. After submitting your application, monitor your application status on My ASU.

After admission to ASU

1. Receive academic advising and register for classes.

Incoming students are required to meet with an academic advisor to enroll in classes.

Class to consider

ASU offers a veteran-specific introductory course to support veterans' transition to academic life. Both first-year and transfer student veterans from any major are welcome to register.

2. Complete ASU's documents for VA benefits processing.

Processing your submitted documents and forms will take approximately one to two business days. Forms may be completed after meeting with an academic advisor and registering for your classes.

3. Determine your residency.

Use ASU's residency navigator to help determine your eligibility for residency.

4. Register for the veterans welcome event.

For on-campus students, the veterans welcome event is a seminar-style orientation. It is expected that all incoming graduate and undergraduate student veterans attend the welcome event prior to their first semester at ASU. If you are a new student, you will receive notifications by mail and email prior to the event so you can RSVP and make plans to attend. We look forward to seeing you there. For ASU Online students, please reach out to your assigned success coach to discuss your available resources and events.

How to pay for college

ASU is here to help you.

You don't have to pay for this investment alone. ASU accepts several types of financial aid, including grants, scholarships, Federal Work-Study and loans, so you can choose what works for you and focus on your academic goals. We are here to help you make informed decisions about how to pay for college.

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid is now open.

Here's your step-by-step guide to submitting your FAFSA and finding out what kind of financial aid is available to help you pay for college.

Step 1: Determine if you are a dependent or independent student for the FAFSA.

Dependent students must include their parents' information on the FAFSA. To determine your dependency status and whose parent information a dependent student will need to provide, answer the following questions.

What is my dependency status?

- I am at least 24 years old.
- I am married.
- I will be working on a master's or doctorate program (e.g., MA, MBA, MD, JD, PhD, EdD, graduate certificate).
- I am serving on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces.
- I am a veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces.
- I now have or will have children for whom I will provide more than half of their support.
- I have dependents (other than children or my spouse) who live with me, and I provide more than half of their support.
- I am currently or I was in legal guardianship.
- I am homeless or I am at risk of being homeless.

If you can check any of these boxes, you qualify as independent and will not have to provide parental information. If you check none of them, you are a dependent and need to provide parental information.

Step 2: Set up your FSA ID.

Create student and parent accounts at studentaid.gov. Do this ahead of time. It takes a couple of days to receive your FSA ID. Write this ID in a secure location. You'll use the same ID every year when you resubmit the FAFSA for financial aid. Each student and parent will need their own phone number and email address to set up their FSA ID.

Your credits

ASU accepts college-level (not remedial) courses in which you have earned a grade of "C" (4.00="A") or better from regionally accredited colleges and universities.

Degree requirements

The ASU college of your major determines how transfer courses fulfill your degree requirements. You should review the degree requirements of the program you intend to transfer to in its major map, and talk with an academic advisor about your transfer credits and how they will apply to your degree program. Some ASU majors have higher admission requirements. To find the requirements for your specific program, visit ASU's Degree Search.

Credit hours

ASU will accept a maximum of 64 semester hours of lower-division credit when transferred from a regionally accredited community, junior or two-year college, with the exception of some special programs. An unlimited number of credit hours will be accepted from four-year institutions.

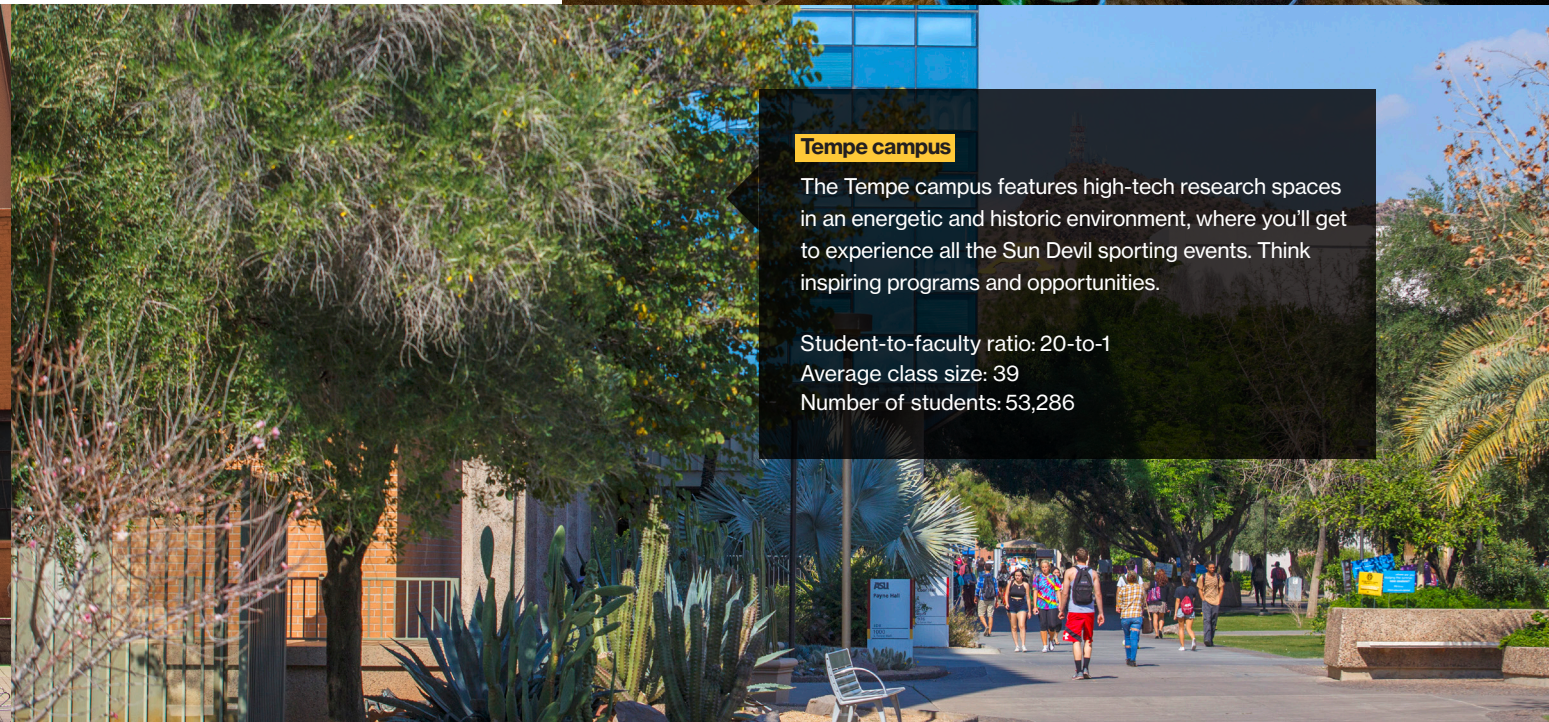

The Downtown Phoenix campus plays an essential role in the health care, journalism, public service and corporate communities. Think professional and fast-paced.

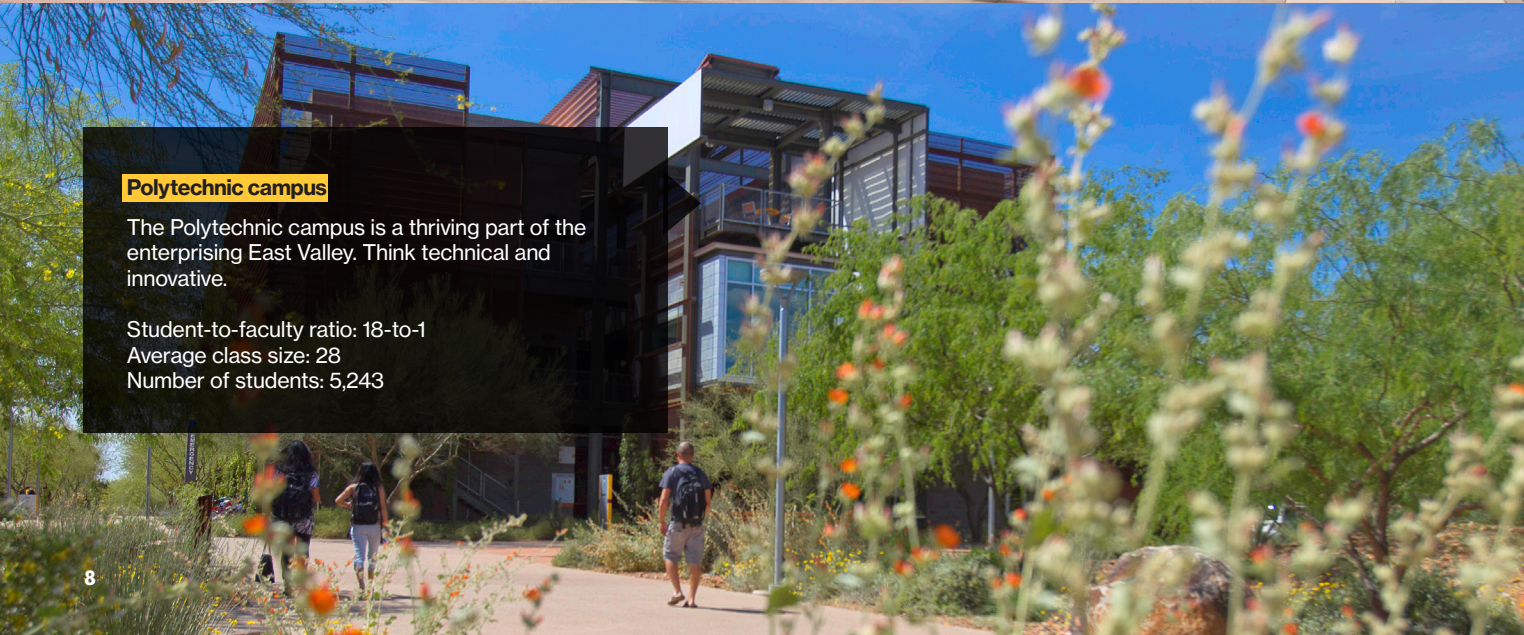

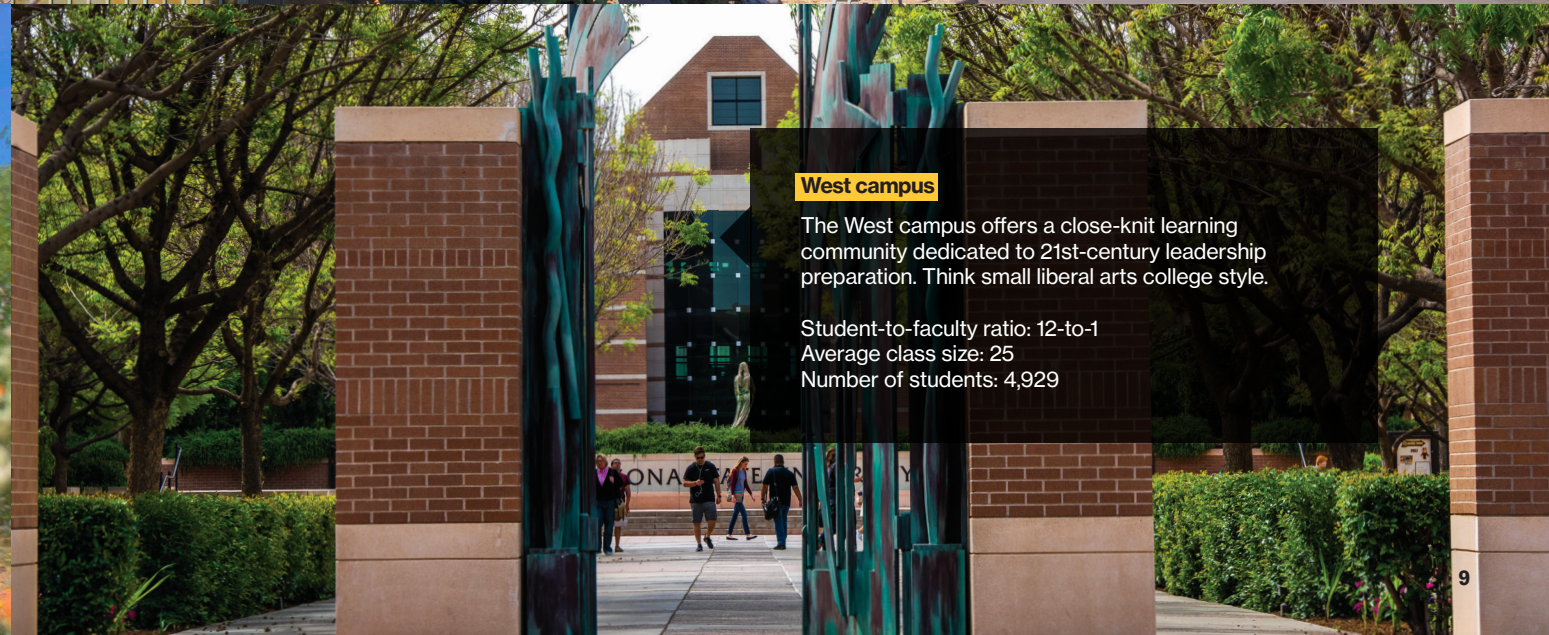
