Here are the top three components of ASU's valuable transfer student experience:

- 1. Assured, rolling admission. As embodied in our charter, ASU prides itself on inclusion and excellence. That extends to our admission process as well. While some majors have higher admission requirements, ASU offers rolling admission to students who meet the requirements for both ASU and their major. Rolling admission means no firm deadlines - just apply when you're ready and allow four to six weeks to complete the application process. asu.edu/transfer-apply
- 2. MyPath2ASU\*. Transfer partnerships with colleges and universities help you by outlining which courses you can take now that will transfer to your ASU major. Signing up for a pathway program can save you time and money, and you'll have guaranteed admission to your ASU degree program when you meet admission requirements. admission.asu.edu/MyPath2ASU

# Steps to apply to ASU

Step 01	Ensure you're meeting ASU's transfer admission requirements before applying. If your major has additional requirements, make sure you're meeting those too.  asu.edu/transfer-apply
Step <b>02</b>	Complete an admission application.  asu.edu/apply
Step <b>03</b>	Activate your ASURITE User ID to access My ASU to track your application status. If you've previously applied to ASU or signed up for MyPath2ASU* through the Maricopa Community Colleges, use your existing ASURITE User ID and password to access My ASU.  my.asu.edu
Step <b>04</b>	Submit your nonrefundable application fee. You can pay the fee when you submit your application, or later through My ASU. The fee is required to process your application.
Step <b>05</b>	Request to have your official transcripts sent to ASU from all previous institutions you've attended. Allow seven to 10 business days for ASU to process transcripts once they're received. Once your application file is complete, allow two to four weeks to receive an admission decision.  admission.asu.edu/apply/transcripts

#### Credits accepted by ASU


ASU accepts college-level (not remedial) courses in which you have earned a grade of "C-" (4.00="A") or better from regionally accredited colleges and universities. Upon admission to the university, you will work with an ASU academic advisor to determine how your transferable credits apply toward your major.

## How to pay for college

Financial aid can cover some or all of your expenses, but you have to know the various types of aid out there and how to apply for them. It all starts by filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, or FAFSA. File by ASU's priority filing date of Jan. 15, 2025, to receive the most aid possible. The 2025 FAFSA application opens fall 2024.

### Why FAFSA?

The FAFSA gives you access to many need-based sources of financial aid you may not be able to access otherwise, including:

- Grants (money you don't repay)
- Federal Work-Study (money you earn from a student job)
- Low-interest federal loans (less expensive than private loans in the long run)

## Steps to complete your FAFSA

1. (	Go to <b>fafsa.gov</b> .
	Log in using your FSA ID. Learn more about the FSA ID at studentaid.gov/help/fsa-id.
3. \$	Submit your FAFSA application.
•	Spring 2025 admits: select the 2024–2025 application. The 2024–2025 FAFSA application is open.
•	Fall 2025 admits: select the 2025–2026 application. The 2025–2026 FAFSA application opens fall 2024.
4.	Add ASU as a school selection (ASU's Federal School

## Finished your FAFSA? Here's what to do next

#### Monitor your financial aid on My ASU

Once you've submitted your FAFSA, allow three to five business days for ASU to receive it. Then, you can track the status of your financial aid on the Finances tab of My ASU. If you are selected for financial aid verification, you will receive an email from ASU notifying you to check your Priority Tasks for a list of requested items.

#### Apply for scholarships

There are lots of scholarships out there, including opportunities based on academic achievement, talent, personal stories, creativity and more. #### **Review your Financial Aid Notification**

After you've been admitted to ASU, submitted your FAFSA and completed your financial aid file, you will receive a Financial Aid Notification detailing your financial aid package. To receive the full amount of aid you are eligible for, enroll full time (minimum 12 credit hours each semester) – any less and your award will be adjusted to match your cost of attendance.
