# Steps to apply to ASU

Step 01	Ensure you're meeting ASU's transfer admission requirements before applying. If your major has additional requirements, make sure you're meeting those too.  asu.edu/transfer-apply
Step <b>02</b>	Complete an admission application.  asu.edu/apply
Step 03	Activate your ASURITE User ID to access My ASU to track your application status. If you've previously applied to ASU or signed up for MyPath2ASU® through the Maricopa Community Colleges, use your existing ASURITE User ID and password to access My ASU.  my.asu.edu
Step <b>04</b>	Submit your nonrefundable application fee. You can pay the fee when you submit your application, or later through My ASU. The fee is required to process your application.
Step <b>05</b>	Request to have your official transcripts sent to ASU from all previous institutions you've attended. Allow seven to 10 business days for ASU to process transcripts once they're received. Once your application file is complete, allow two to four weeks to receive an admission decision.  admission.asu.edu/apply/transcripts

#### Credits accepted by ASU

ASU accepts college-level (not remedial) courses in which you have earned a grade of "C-" (4.00="A") or higher from regionally accredited colleges and universities. Upon admission to the university, you will work with an ASU academic advisor to determine how your transferable credits apply toward your major.



## How to pay for college

Financial aid can cover some or all of your expenses, but you have to know the various types of aid out there and how to apply for them. It all starts by filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, or FAFSA.

The 2025–2026 FAFSA application is open.

#### Why FAFSA?

The FAFSA gives you access to many need-based sources of financial aid you may not be able to access otherwise, including:

- Grants (money you don't repay)
- Federal Work-Study (money you earn from a student job)
- Low-interest federal loans (less expensive than private loans in the long run)

#### Steps to complete your FAFSA

l. Go to <b>fafsa.gov</b> .
2. Log in using your FSA ID. Learn more about the FSA ID at <b>studentaid.gov/help/fsa-id</b> .
3. Submit your FAFSA.
<ul> <li>Fall 2025 and spring 2026 admits: Select the 2025–2026 application. The 2025–2026 application is open.</li> </ul>
• Fall 2026 admits: Select the 2026–2027 application. The 2026–2027 application opens Oct. 1, 2025.
4. Add ASU as a school selection (ASU's Federal School Code: 001081).

# Finished your FAFSA? Here's what to do next

#### Monitor your financial aid on My ASU

Once you've submitted your FAFSA, allow three to five business days for ASU to receive it. Then, you can track the status of your financial aid on the Finances tab on My ASU. If you're selected for financial aid verification, you'll receive an email from ASU notifying you to check your Priority Tasks for a list of requested items.

#### Apply for scholarships

#### **Review your Financial Aid Notification**

After you've been admitted to ASU, submitted your FAFSA and completed your financial aid file, you'll receive a Financial Aid Notification detailing your financial aid package. To receive the full amount of aid you're eligible for, enroll full time (minimum 12 credit hours each semester) – any less and your scholarships will be adjusted to match your cost of attendance.

#### Use the budget worksheet

Creating an annual budget is an important part of your ASU experience — it helps you understand your total costs, see how your financial aid scholarships help cover those costs, and anticipate a possible remaining balance due to ASU after your aid is applied.
